

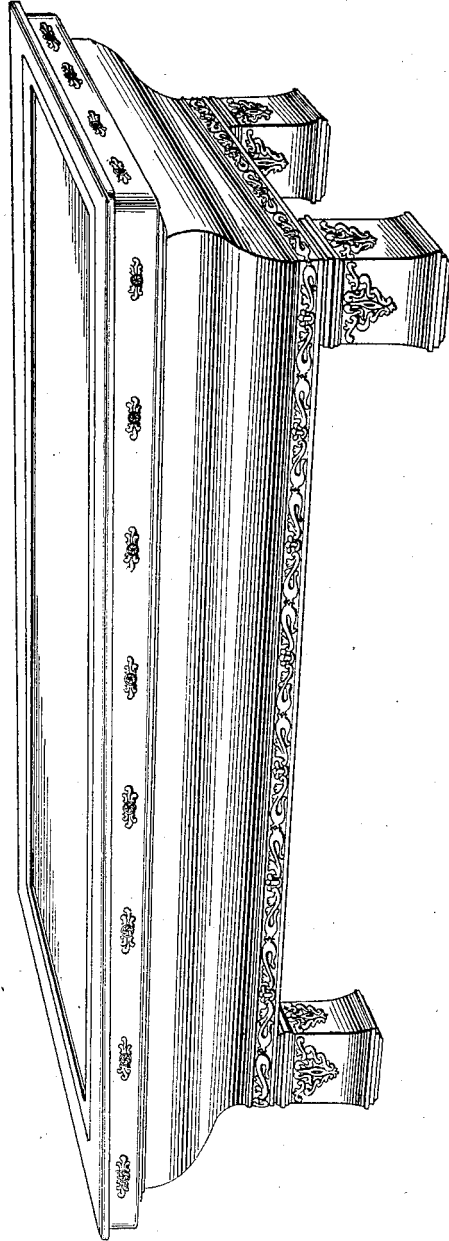

## DESIGN FOR A BILLIARD-TABLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,662, dated December 1, 1903.

Application filed September 24, 1903. Serial No. 174,526. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOHN EHRENPREIS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Billiard-Tables, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
