

GREENLEAF WINS TWICE.

Captures Two Exhibition Pocket Billiard Matches—Enters Tourney.

Ralph Greenleaf has announced that he has entered the championship pocket billiard tournament to be held in Philadelphia Dec. 1 to 13, inclusive. Greenleaf is conceded to have an excellent chance to win the title. He began serious practice for the event by engaging in two exhibition matches at the Morningside Billiard Academy yesterday afternoon and last night. He defeated George Worden, his manager, in both games by 125 to 93 and 125 to 79, respectively. Greenleaf had a high run of 63 balls. Ralph is playing particularly good pocket billiards at this time. He plays more consistently than ever before. He is steadier at the table and not so prone to try almost impossible combinations as he was formerly.

At the same place tonight he will play William Morris, an amateur of pronounced ability. On Saturday night Greenleaf is scheduled to play George Clark, formerly New York State champion.
