

GIRL DROPS LOVE SUIT AGAINST N. E. BENSINGER

Following her failure to appear to prosecute the case, Judge Franklin H. Boggs yesterday dismissed the \$10,000 breach of promise suit brought by Miss Helen Earle against Norman E. Bensinger, grandson of the founder of the Brunswick-Balke-Cottler company.

The suit was filed in 1921, and alleged that Bensinger, whose father, Louis A. Bensinger, is well known as the owner of numerous loop billiard halls, promised on several occasions to marry Miss Earle.

~~Two weeks after the suit was filed.~~ Mrs. Jeanette Bensinger, filed suit for ~~divorcement~~ which was granted on grounds of cruelty. No mention of Miss Earle was made in Mrs. Bensinger's bill.

Attorney Charles E. Erbstein, counsel for Bensinger, moved for dismissal.
