

L. A. BENSINGER'S WILL DISPOSES OF ABOUT \$50,000

The will of Louis A. Bensinger, proprietor of a chain of billiard rooms and bowling alleys, was filed yesterday before Edward S. Scheffler, assistant to Probate Judge Henry Horner. The testament, dated Sept. 12, 1910, bequeaths all his property to his widow, Mrs. Lilly Bensinger, 3800 Sheridan road. The estate is officially estimated at \$50,000 but it is understood that he carried much of his property in his wife's name. Mr. Bensinger was struck and killed by an automobile on May 2. He was 70 years old. Besides his widow, he is survived by a son, Norman E. Bensinger, 3100 Sheridan road, who took over the management of his father's interests several months ago.
