

# SCHAEFER SETS HIGH RUN RECORD IN BEATING HOPPE

Jake Schaefer Jr. of San Francisco broke the world's high run record in cushion carom billiards last night in winning the second block of his 1,500 point match with Willie Hoppe for the world's championship.

Schaefer scored 265 points to Hoppe's 250 in 44 innings with a high run of 39. The old high run record was 38, set by George F. Slosson in 1883. Hoppe now leads in total points, 500 to 462. Hoppe's high run during the night's game was 28.

At the end of the first ten innings of the block Hoppe was leading, 279 to 244, and twenty innings later he was still out in front, 404 to 385. Ten frames later he was leading Schaefer, 464 to 451, a margin which he maintained through the three remaining innings of the block. He ended the block with an unfinished run of eight.

The third block of the match will be played this evening at the Morrison hotel, starting at 8:15 p. m. Score by innings:
