

GEORGE SUTTON, HANDLESS CUE STAR, IS DEAD

Toldeo, On May 15.—(AP)—George H. Sutton, 68 years old, pool and billiard expert despite a handicap imposed early in life when he lost both hands in a sawmill accident, died of a heart attack here today in his camp car. During the last year he toured the country, lecturing and appearing in exhibitions as an employé of a Chicago billiard company.

Despite his handicap, George H. Sutton competed on equal terms with all but the very front rank of professional billiard players, and in exhibitions he had defeated some of the leaders. He had toured the country annually for thirty-five years.
