

Lincoln, Neb., Nov. 11. (4).—Nebraska repulsed a late pass attack and emerged with a 7 to 0 victory today in its 46th annual football game with Kansas before 26,000.

Kansas kept the Cornhuskers between the 30 yard lines for the most part of the contest. In the second period the Cornhuskers took the ball on a punt on the Kansas 32 and five plays later crashed thru to the winning touchdown. Herman Rohrig went thru left tackle, squirmed away from two tacklers, cut off to the right and lunged over the goal line. Rohrig kicked the extra point from placement.
