To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Donald Deskey, a citizen of the United States, resident in the city of New York, in the county of New York, State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Rack or the Like for Billiard Cues, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a rack or the like for billiard cues, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale.

The ornamental design for a rack or the like for billiard cues, as shown.
