

# C. F. CONKLIN WON AND LOST.

## Chicago Expert Victor by Seven Points in Afternoon Game of Class A Billiard Tournament.

C. F. Conklin, the Chicago expert, who finished first in the Class A 14.2 billiard tourney last year and challenged Wilson P. Foss for the championship, won and lost yesterday in this year's tourney in the theatre of the Knickerbocker Athletic Club. Opposed to him in the afternoon contest was Threshie, his opponent in the deciding game last year, which Conklin won by just one point. The game yesterday was almost as stubbornly played, but the spectators' interest waned before the finish of the long-drawn-out contest of 88 innings, the final score of which was 400 to 393.

W. H. Sigourney, the Pacific Coast champion, was Conklin's opponent in the evening game and Sigourney won a fairly fast contest of 57 innings by a score of 400 to 350. The men were within hailing distance of each other during the entire game, and it was due to a run of 50 made in the fifty-fifth inning that Sigourney won his game. Sigourney made several other fair runs, the best of these being 31. Conklin played steadily all the way through, and his best run was 22. The scores:
